



Spotlight on **Arneis**....

Arneis is a white Italian grape, originally from the Piedmont region. Moon Curser is, to the best of our knowledge, the only winery in Canada growing and making Arneis. We fell in love with this variety for a number of reasons, not least of which is the name. In the local dialect of Piedmont, it means "little rascal".....

Italy was the theme country at the recent [2016 Vancouver International Wine Festival](#) where Italy's indigenous varietals , **Arneis** included, were discussed in three seminars led by Ian D'Agata, the author of an acclaimed book "Native Wine Grapes of Italy".

Canada's own wine authority, [John Schreiner](#), attended the seminars and shared his findings of the colourful history of Arneis [on his blog](#) - a fascinating peak at **Arneis** and its climb back from **near extinction** to become a rising star of Italian grape varieties being planted outside of that country.
